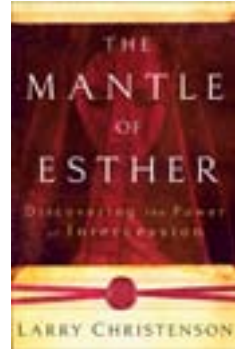


Welcome Visitors ~ New Member Classes
