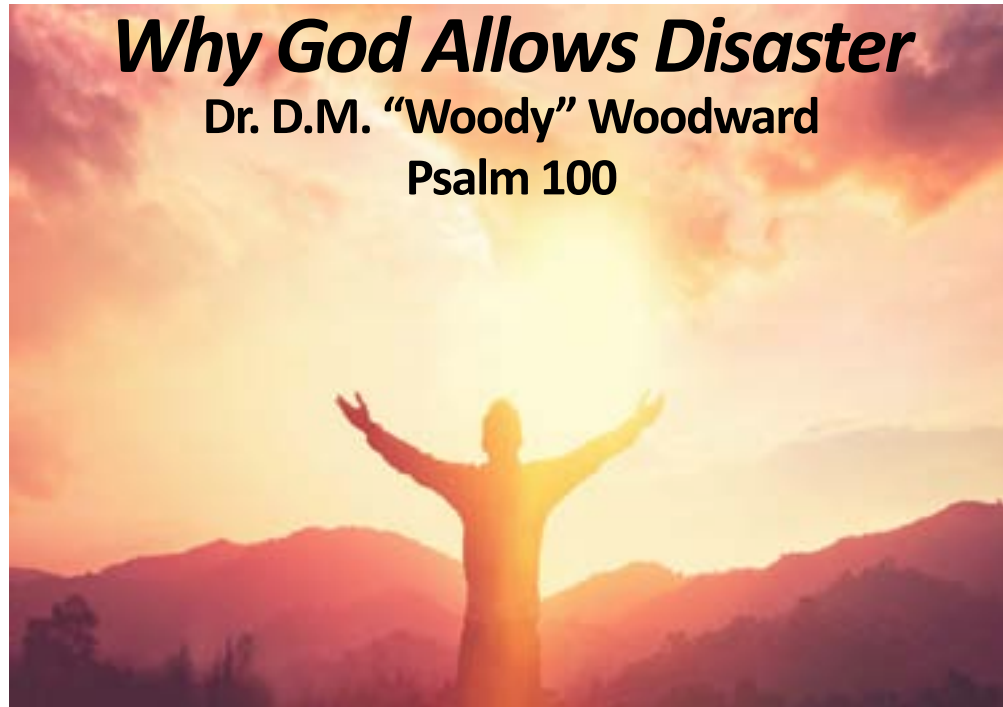


Why God Allows Disaster
