## This Sunday

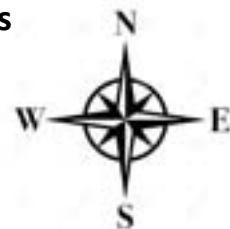
The radio broadcast for this week is given in loving memory of Elton Specht on his birthday, by MaryAnn and family.
