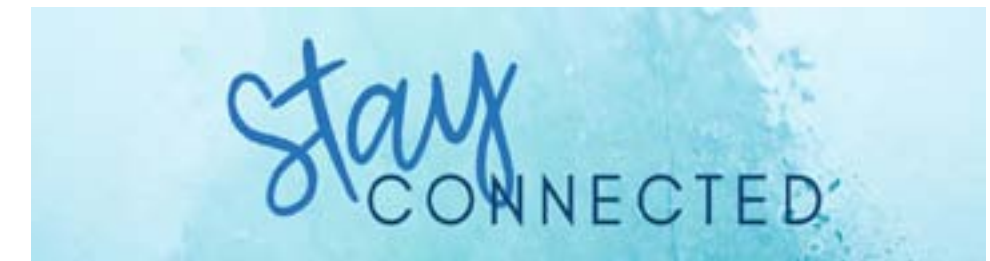
NEW MEMBERS CLASS
