This week's radio broadcast is given in celebration of the 100th birthday of Calvin Henze, by his wife Irene and his family

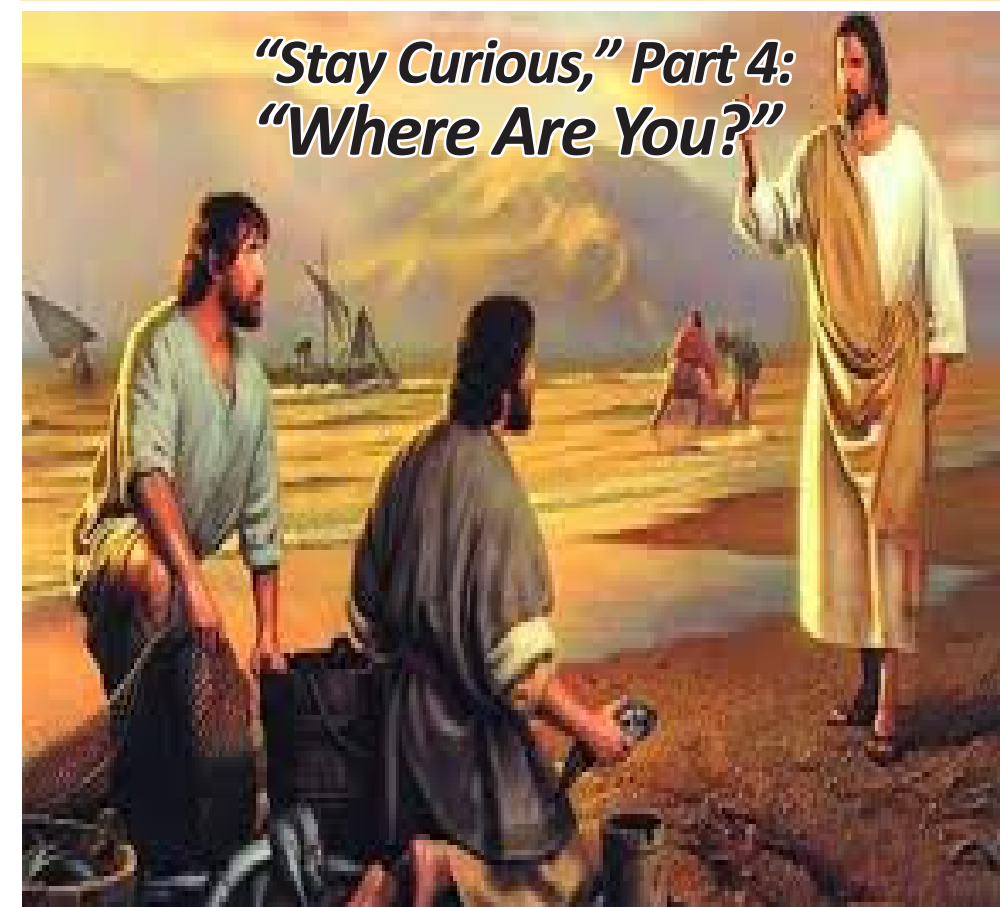
