

## How to make a Palm Cross

 <b>STEP 1</b> Turn the palm cross over and fold the extra length diagonally down to the right, like a sash.	 <b>STEP 2</b> Turn your palm cross over.  <b>STEP 8</b> Run the extra length straight across, left to right, right under the "arms."	 <b>STEP 9</b> Wrap the extra length behind the cross, diagonally up and to the left.	 <b>STEP 10</b> Tuck any extra length into the loops on the back of the cross (the side facing you) to secure your cross.	 <b>STEP 11</b> Make any adjustments as needed. Then carefully crease the folds so your cross looks nice and tidy.
