Special Congregational Meeting Update

Dear FPC Family,

Sunday, July 12, a properly called Special Congregational meeting was held after the 10:00am combined Service. The church Constitution/ByLaws state that the church may, at any time, by a majority vote of the active members present at a Special Congregational meeting called for the specific purpose of termination, request the Senior Minister’s resignation with a requirement that it will be presented within seven (7) days.

A total of 266 active members were present and voted. A tally of the votes reveal 233 “FOR” and 33 “AGAINST” the termination of the call agreement.

We extend our thanks to all members that were present.

Your Council is at work now arranging for an interim pastor to join us. Right after that we will form a Pastor Search Committee.

Please continue to pray for the church, the staff, Pastor Andrew and his family, and your Council as we regain our momentum.
