The auditorium became a social hub for the church and the community. It saw many school plays, graduations, musicals and dance recitals, games and practice place for various music groups.

During WWII the basement was set up for an emergency hospital. Supplies were stored there should an emergency arise. It was also used as an air raid shelter during WWII.
